APHSA envisions a future of human services that is human-centered, community-driven, and driven by a fierce commitment to equity, diversity, inclusion, and belonging (EDIB). Drawing on participatory action research (PAR) principles, APHSA seeks to bring human services practitioners, researchers, and people with lived experience together in a one-day workshop extension at the 2024 Economic Mobility and Well-Being (EMWB) conference.

Through this workshop, participants will explore how to effectively collaborate with people with lived experience (PWLE) in human services research and co-design an economic mobility and well-being research agenda for the human services sector with community members. The symposium is planned to feature:

- A full-day workshop is planned and facilitated in partnership with PWLE.
- Attendees learn PAR basics and its practical application
 to human services work, including fostering relationships
 between researchers, practitioners, and PWLE; translating
 PAR into sound human services policy and practice; and
 leveraging PAR to enhance and promote EDIB.
- Participation from researchers, human services leaders, and practitioners, and PWLE.
- Attendees identify human services-specific use cases that are ripe for applying PAR within human services, leading to concrete action stemming from the Symposium.
